What it takes to become a RFDS Ambassador

RFDS Ambassadors are an extension of our organisation and will positively reflect the RFDS (Queensland Section) and our values.

You are, or wish to be, actively committed to building awareness about health and wellbeing in your local community. Ambassadors should:

- embody the values of the RFDS (Queensland Section) by being inclusive, transparent, collaborative and innovative
- be compassionate, tenacious and energetic, and engender mutual respect and trust
- · possess a deep understanding of the RFDS, our history and range of services
- be familiar with our services and skilled at making new connections
- be great at engaging with people and know how to strike up and hold a conversation!



Your role

As a RFDS Ambassador, you will help spread awareness of the Flying Doctor and deepen the connection the RFDS has with Queenslanders. Ambassadors will show their commitment to the work of the RFDS through a range of activities (that suit their knowledge, skills, networks and availability) including but not limited to:

- representing the RFDS at community events across
 Queensland and speaking to the public about our work. This
 includes presenting awards or accepting donations, acting
 as an MC, presence at RFDS Open Days and signature
 events e.g. Galas
- engaging in regular conversations with the community and your network about the RFDS to create awareness of our mission and community projects
- · promoting the RFDS on social media and other channels
- · participating in RFDS campaigns and initiatives
- · building relationships with supporters, donors and partners
- · representing the RFDS in agreed media activity
- positively advocating for the RFDS (Queensland Section)
- participating in fundraising and commercial activity for the RFDS. This includes attending fundraising events and a willingness to be engaged as the 'voice' or 'face' of advertising campaigns for RFDS products and services such as Rescue Swag.





Helping you light the way

We want to make sure all RFDS Ambassadors feel equipped to carry out their role confidently and effectively. To support you in this role, we will provide sufficient briefing materials and a tailored calendar of events.

Our Ambassador Team will be will be able to assist in answering questions, queries or concerns.

Upon your appointment as a RFDS Ambassador, you can expect:

- a welcome and orientation meeting at your local RFDS base
- an induction pack containing RFDS presentations, key facts and capability information
- a welcome pack containing RFDS branded collateral and apparel
- regular contact with our Ambassador Coordinator to provide updates on our work and to offer any advice or guidance relating to your role
- opportunities to connect with ambassadors working in other regions.

How to get involved

Follow these six steps to become a RFDS Ambassador:

1. Read and sign the Ambassador Agreement and Code of Conduct

You will receive a copy with your invitation to join our program.

2. Attend welcome orientation

Held at your closest RFDS (Queensland Section) base, you will receive training and a welcome pack while meeting RFDS staff and other ambassadors in your area. A RFDS staff member will be in contact to arrange your base visit.

3. Start shining!

Once you have completed the induction training, you can start your ambassador role.

4. Support

You will receive all the support you need to carry out your role effectively.

5. Stay connected

Keep in touch with fellow RFDS Ambassadors via our private WhatsApp group.

6. Offboarding

At the end of your one-year tenure, the RFDS team will work with you to offboard you from your duties.
