

#### **Our History**

Based at Launceston Airport, the Royal Flying Doctor Service Tasmania was officially formed on September 12th 1960, and has steadily grown over the past 64 years.

Today, we provide physical, mental and dental health services to rural and remote Tasmanian communities.

#### **Our Mission**

RFDS Tasmania supports individuals and communities in rural areas with healthcare that would be otherwise inaccessible due to distance and terrain.

By removing the barriers to care of Tasmanian communities, we strive to improve the health outcomes of all Tasmanians.

#### Our Programs

**Physical Health -** Providing group and individual physical health consultations to treat chronic conditions.

**Mental Health -** Supporting adults and youth with counselling services across ten local government areas.

**Dental Health –** Mobile clinics deliver treatment to all ages where dental care is otherwise unavailable.



# Why we need volunteers

#### Volunteers are vital to RFDS function

The Royal Flying Doctor Service relies on volunteers Australia-wide.

In Tassie, our volunteers reduce administration costs and make sure more of the donations and fundraising dollars we receive go directly toward providing physical, mental and dental services to Tasmanian communities.

Every task our volunteers perform helps us keep our costs low and our reach wide.

# How our volunteers help

# O1 Attending events

Events are just one way that we promote our services. Out in the fields under the marquee, or at a regional community hall it is often our volunteers talking to event goers about our physical, mental and dental health programs.

# O2 Driving special RFDS vehicles

While our branded cars can be seen traveling from Bruny Island to Smithton, the RFDS Tasmania fleet also includes two ex-Metro Tasmania Scania N113CRB buses, two custom-built Mercedes Sprinter dental vans and the Isuzu D-MAX that tows our cut-down aircraft, also known as the SIM (educational simulator).

Our invaluable volunteers use their skills, experience and special vehicle licenses to drive these custom vehicles and help us get where we're needed most.

# O3 Providing feedback on our documents

It is RFDS Tasmania policy to ensure that those that receive our services are consulted in the development of our publications. This way we can be sure we are meeting our consumers' needs in the information we provide.

All RFDS Tasmania volunteers must have a current Working with Vulnerable People (WWVP) card, which includes a police check.

To operate our vehicles, you must have the appropriate licenses. For example, a medium rigid license for the dental vans and a heavy rigid license for the buses.

To tow the simulator, as well as your Tasmanian driver's license, you should have experience towing a long/heavy trailer, such as a caravan or a boat.
